# DIRECTIONS

**Stonewall Golf Club:** Located at 15601 Turtle Point Drive, Gainesville, VA 20155. Telephone number is 703-753-5101.

**From points South:** I-95 to Rt. 17 North (Exit 133) towards Warrenton. After 28 miles, merge onto Route 29 North towards Warrenton and Washington. Travel 16 miles and turn right onto Lake Manassas Drive. Turn right at stop sign onto Turtle Point Drive. Course entrance is on the left.

**From points North:** I-495 to I-66 West (Exit 49) towards Vienna/Front Royal. Travel 21 miles to exit 43A (Rt. 29 South to Gainesville/Warrenton). Go 2.5 miles and turn left (look for the Brass Cannon/Stonewall sign) onto Lake Manassas Drive. Turn right at stop sign onto Turtle Point Drive. Course entrance is on the left.
